## Nooni weekdays

- 1. **Bvutfu** = Day of *Tfuu* (village also called *Mbinon/Noni*)
- 2. **Bvuŋkaa** = Basket day, Day of *Nkor*
- 3. **Bvuzhii** = Black day, day of mercy
- 4. **Bvukema** = Week day, day of reconciliation
- 5. **Bvunkaaden** = Basket day in *Din*
- 6. **Bvuzhiiden** = Black day in *Din*
- 7. Bvu(n)sow = Day of Lamnso
- 8. **Bvumbon** = Day of peace

• word order:

- A (T) **nú** B (**"A is/was B"**)
  - T = ci (near past)
  - $T = \emptyset$  (near future)
- S-T-V-O-(**lé**)-L-D
  - "to see" = yέn (Ο) lé

  - after a consonant, **lé > é** [1 mark]




- Submitted by 195 contestants




